## Materials needed:

- Copy of activity sheet for each student
- crayons
- paint (fall colors)
- Q-tips

## Directions

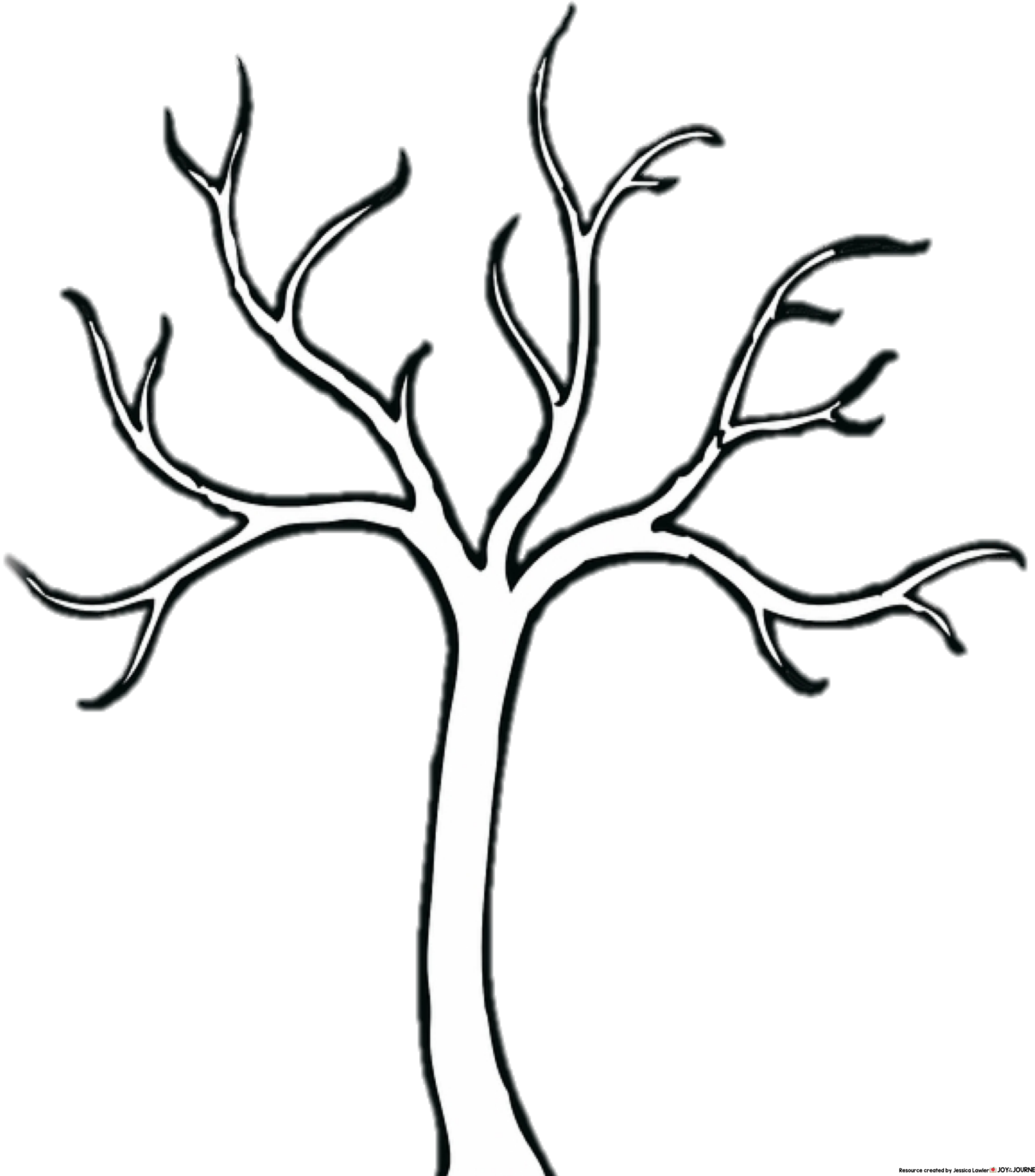
- Give each student a copy of activity sheet
- Have the students color the tree trunk and the letters in the title
- Show them how to carefully dip one end of the Q-tip in the paint and place dots ("leaves") all over the tree branches. Don't forget to include some falling to the ground. Repeat with each color.
- Discuss the important truth that the seasons change, but Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow

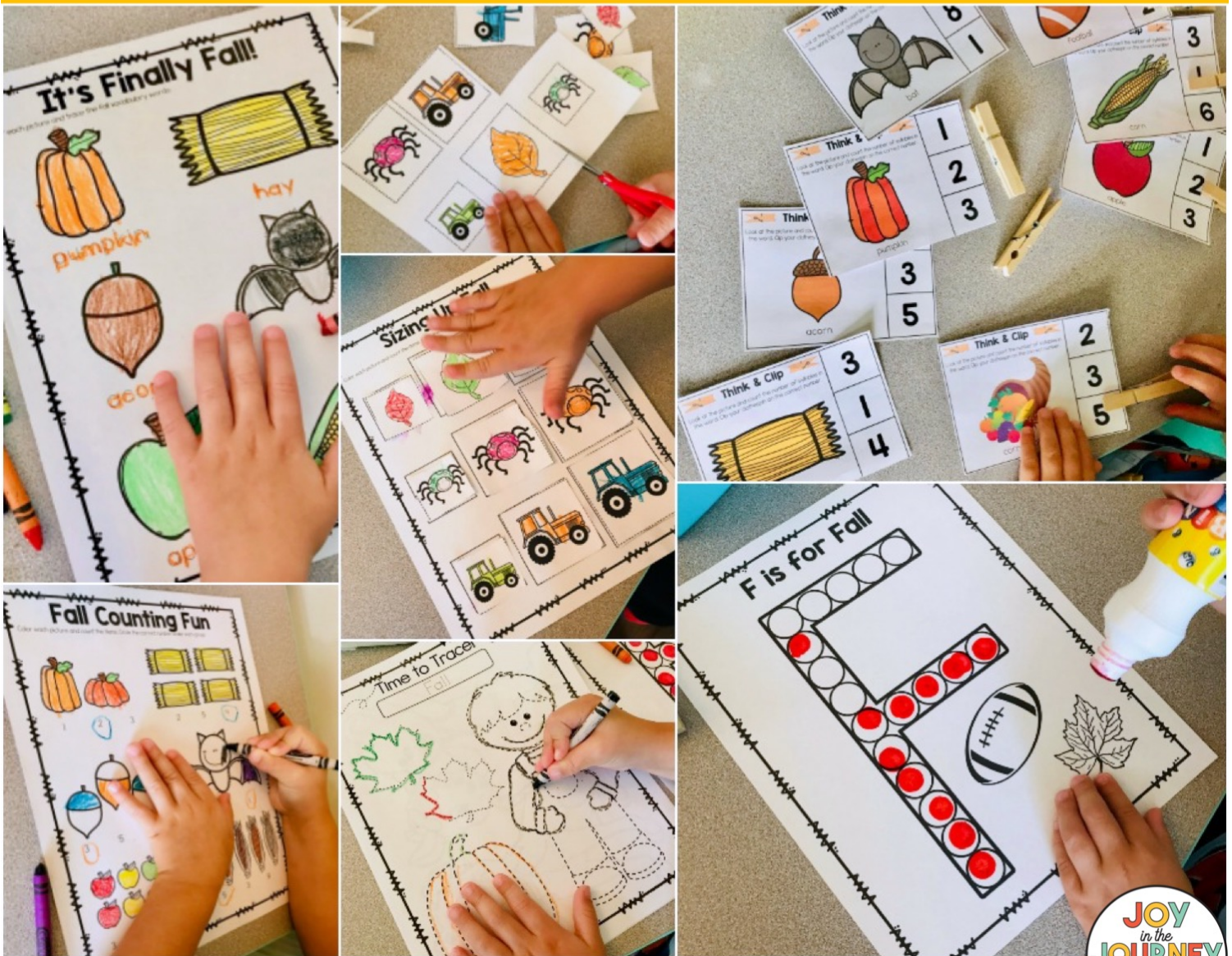
